A CHEST OF DRAWER AS NEVER YOU SAW



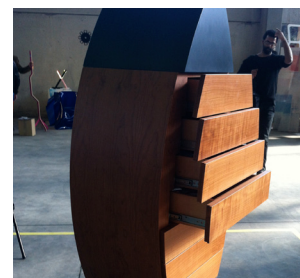
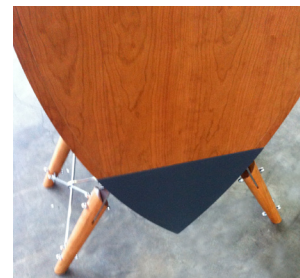
The design of the chest of drawers “Oracle” is its universal and primordial that refers to ancient symbols. The choice of the number of drawers is traditional: 7 as the days of the week and is around this number that develops all its measures.

A magic number rich in meaning that accompanies humanity in history.

The drawers are smooth in the front and have a groove on the side that makes it easy to open. The body structure is constructed with an aeronautical technique. Curtainsiders allow the insertion of the sliding mechanism for the drawers and provide support for the outer cover. Even supports are inspired by the aeronautical technique: spears bent metal that connect to the body of the drawers with chrome screws are inserted in the wood truncated cone legs. A horizontal tension bar with hooks at the ends serves as a structural brace.

Materials: Wood Cherry with lacquered parts, bolts and screws chrome.

Dimensions: 70 x 42 x 161 cm h
